SUBJECT: Fiscal Note

House Bill (LC 41 0886)

## Dear Representative Petrea:

This bill would make the Georgia Bureau of Investigation (GBI) responsible for issuing guidelines to be used by jails to determine the nationality of a confined person. I Jails would be required to provide GBI with a monthly listing of the names, aliases, nationality, immigration status, immigration and employment authorization form identification numbers, violations or charges, and prior arrests and convictions of non-citizens detained in the jail during the prior month. Jails must also provide a list of individuals released during the previous month who were the subject of an immigration detainer request by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE). To the extent permitted by federal law, both lists would be published each month on GBI's website. GBI would also be responsible for ensuring that jails comply with the statute and for reporting the local governments that fail to do so to state funding providers who may withhold state and federal funding for law enforcement during the period of noncompliance and for six months after noncompliance ends.

GBI officials indicated that the bill would result in one-time and recurring costs. As shown in **Table 1**, the costs to implement the required monthly reporting function would include approximately \$75,000 in one-time computer equipment costs and recurring costs of approximately \$227,000 annually for a database administrator, two help desk analysts, and ongoing IT costs. These costs would provide for the creation and management of a web-based database for local authorities to enter the required information and publication of the reports, as well as staff to deal with the jails submitting the information and those making requests as a result of the published material (e.g., additional information; incorrect information). Our estimate does not include any compliance costs that may be incurred by local governments.
