House Bill (LC 33 8866)

Dear Representative Scott:

This bill would require the Georgia Department of Human Services (DHS) to apply for a U.S. Department of Agriculture waiver to allow SNAP/WIC recipients to purchase diapers and menstrual products.

DHS did not expect any impact to state funds for costs associated with the bill. The Department of Public Health, which administers the WIC program, also did not expect any impact to state funds associated with the bill. Both programs are funded by the federal government, and any additional funding needed to implement this bill would be requested from federal funds.
