Senate Bill 487 (LC 52 0086)

Dear Chairman Burke:

This bill will add a new Code section requiring that diagnostic breast examinations not be treated less favorably than screening mammography for breast cancer with respect to cost-sharing requirements. This bill would apply to all applicable insurance policies issued, delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after July 1, 2022.

The Officer of the Commissioner of Insurance and Safety Fire (OCI), the state agency that regulates insurance, anticipates that it will be able to implement the provisions of the bill without additional funds or resources.
