House Bill (LC 43 2494)

Dear Representative Buckner:

This bill would dedicate hazardous waste and hazardous substance reporting fees collected under O.C.G.A. 12-8-95.1 for the Hazardous Waste Trust Fund. Money collected for the periods beginning July 1, 2023 and ending on June 30, 2032 would not be available for appropriations to programs other than the Trust Fund.

In the last five fiscal years, combined collections for the two revenue sources above ranged from \$1.21 million in FY 2022 to \$1.69 million in FY 2020. The average over the five-year period ending FY 2022 was \$1.4 million.
