SUBJECT: Fiscal Note

House Bill (LC 57 0301)

Dear Representative Barnes:

The bill would require the Department of Driver Services (DDS) to allow applicants to include a notation on their driver's license signifying a development disability. The Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council (POST) and the Georgia Public Safety Training Center (GPSTC) must incorporate into training methods for identifying and responding to the notation.

None of the three agencies anticipates the need for additional resources to comply with the bill's provisions. DDS currently allows individuals seeking driver's licenses or identification cards to note if they have a developmental disability on their application (accompanied with a medical doctor's signature), and the developmental disability will be noted on the back of the license. Both GPSTC and POST also indicated that any changes to training would be relatively minimal and not require additional funding.
