House Bill 1112 (LC 62 0462S)

Dear Chairman Hufstetler:

The bill would provide for the rounding of the total price of the sale of goods and services by merchants for purchases made by currency or coin. It would also require merchants to accept exact payment as long as the penny remains legal tender. The bill states that no state or local taxes apply to losses or gains resulting from rounding.

We determined that the bill would have no fiscal impact on state government.
