SUBJECT:	Intent to Waive Intergovernmental Review for Selected Uni Department of Agriculture (USDA) Rural Development Los Programs	

Based on the requirements of Executive Order 12372, Intergovernmental Review of Federal Programs, any state clearinghouse has the right to not select a program for intergovernmental review, should it so decide.

Effective **October 1, 2004**, Georgia State Clearinghouse will discontinue intergovernmental review of the following types of USDA Rural Development loans/grants except as noted:

- 1. <u>Equipment Purchases</u> (Ex: fire trucks, police cars, emergency vehicles, truck driving simulators, etc.)
- 2. <u>Technical Assistance</u> (Ex: study, survey, conference, etc.)
- **3.** <u>Miscellaneous</u> (Ex: inventory, operating/working capital, refinancing/restructuring debt/recapitalizing, etc.)

**EXCEPTIONS:** Any loan or grant that will be used to fund ANY type of construction, renovation or rehabilitation, that will involve State funds, or that will have significant statewide impact, <u>must be</u> <u>submitted to and processed through the intergovernmental review by the Georgia State</u> <u>Clearinghouse</u>.
